As part of our learning on the Victorians in the World Around Us, and the water cycle in Science, Years 1, 2 and 3 will be visiting the **Museum of Water and Steam** in Brentford on **Wednesday 27**th **March 2019**.

During our visit, Museum staff will lead a session called **Victorian Washday** where children will get to dress in appropriate costume, and find out how people in nineteenth-century London washed their clothes. They will discover what it was like to have a job as a child, and explore how washing clothes has become easier with the invention of new machines.

We will be using public transport, **leaving school at 9.00am and returning by 3pm**. Please provide your child with a packed lunch and a bottle of water. Children should wear school uniform as usual.

This trip costs **5 pounds** to cover entrance to the Museum and the educational session.
