Dear parent

We are very excited to present to you a new sports opportunity for our Azbuka Primary school children.

All British schools are expected to explore different educational domains and partnerships which will enable children take part in competitive games and sports alongside other schools.

Being a small school presents additional challenges: not being able to form its own team, for example, to compete, interact with, or play, against other schools.

In such cases The Independent School Association will normally help schools form partnerships. However, these can often be located far away and also the ethos of some schools can be rather different to ours. We have to consider this as well as many other factors when forming strategic partnerships.

A couple of years ago, the governors started discussions with **SIAL, an Italian-English bilingual school** in Holland park, similar to Azbuka in philosophy, ethos, practice and size. **We are now looking forward to the opening stage of our partnership which we anticipate will cover many other aspects of school life** (sports, teacher training, pedagogy, moderation etc).

Dingoes Football Club has been working not just with the **Italian school** but also other schools in the area. They are experienced in working with children and schools within the English education system, organising joint games and competitions. They ensure that their staff are fully vetted and provide a fully risk-assessed safe professional environment. **The club will integrate both of our schools into 1 training programme.**

Football and competitive games is a vital element of our school development plan and I hope many children (both girls and boys) will sign up.

This Project will enhance children's team spirit, their interpersonal and social skills, confidence and self-esteem.

It will also enable our students to interact with children of other bilingual European schools in London on a weekly basis and contribute to the growth and raising the profile

of Azbuka school.

I cannot stress the importance of this enough.

Please note that this Dingoes FC is open to all students (**boys and girls**) **regardless of experience and fitness**. There will be opportunities for them to move to a professional level if they wish to (please see the detailed information below).
