On behalf of the governors and staff of Azbuka, we thank you for all your support and understanding at this difficult time. We wish our teachers a very speedy recovery. Get well soon!

Our top priority is the health of our children, teachers and community, alongside our pupils' continued education.

Last summer Azbuka teachers did a great job implementing an online alternative teaching provision for our children.

- Please make sure your child is prepared for their lessons. Your teacher will let you know what to prepare. They will all need pencil/pen and paper to write on.
- The children are expected to follow our normal time-table as much as they possibly can.
- Please ensure your child follows online safety. When searching the internet for research etc, please make sure they use https://primaryschoolict.com/ as this uses strong filters and is used in school.
- When completing projects please <u>supervise</u> your child where necessary (especially Science and Art/DT)
- For siblings: whenever possible, children should work in different rooms on different devices.
- Please don't hesitate to communicate with your class teacher should any issues arise. Please use the teacher's school email address or Class Dojo where they can assist you.
