AZBUKA COVID PROTECTIVE MEASURES/Safeguarding - Spring 2022

Good morning everyone,

We hope you are well and had a restful summer. We are really excited to welcome you all back to school next Monday, 10th January and are ready to return to a more familiar setting now that Covid restrictions have eased. However, we want to make sure that your return is safe and reassuring. With that in mind, we have carried revised our AZBUKA risk assessment, using the latest government advice, and have revised our protective measures, for the coming academic year, which will facilitate this.

AZBUKA PROTECTIVE MEASURES AND SAFEGUARDING PRACTICE DURING SPRING TERM 2022

GENERAL – BOTH PRE-SCHOOL (NURSERY/RECEPTION) AND PRIMARY SCHOOL

*On entry to the building, they should sanitise their hands and go to their class. They must change to their indoor shoes.

*Children will be encouraged to wash their hands at regular intervals. They will also be encouraged to follow the Catch It, Bin It, Kill It routine for coughs and sneezes. Hand sanitisers are located at the entrance to the hall and the kitchen.

During school operation, <u>school parents</u> should not enter the building unless attending a meeting or school event (production, assembly). However, on Fridays, parents are welcome to enter the school to pick up their child and speak to the teachers if needed.

Pick up and drop off for <u>Nursery parents</u>: the arrangements will now resume as normal, you will be asked to come upstairs to drop off/pick up your child from the Nursery (one parents only). For detailed advice and new pick up/drop off Reception arrangements please refer to the Nursery/Reception letter, that will be sent out this week by Oksana Pavlykivska, Nursery manager.

Some meetings are subject to individual circumstances and might still be conducted over the phone or Zoom. Please follow instructions in Communications should you wish to raise any concerns or meet with your teacher.

Enhanced cleaning and Ventilation

The school have organised an enhanced cleaning schedule involving an external company and our own resources. There will be a strict checklist to follow to ensure that all surfaces are disinfected each day. Teachers and teaching assistants will also make sure that at the end of each day, surfaces in classrooms are disinfected. **Ventilation** has also been improved. Windows will remain open whenever possible.

Covid Protocol

The school will use the Government's thresholds for when to take action. Currently those thresholds are:

- 5 children, pupils, students or staff, who are likely to have mixed closely, test positive for COVID-19 within a 10-day period; Or
- 10% of children, pupils, students or staff who are likely to have mixed closely test positive for COVID-19 within a 10-day period

At this point, we will consider:

- whether any activities could take place outdoors, including exercise, assemblies, or classes
- ways to improve ventilation indoors further, where this would not significantly impact thermal comfort
- further enhanced cleaning focussing on touch points and any shared equipment

We will:

- 1. Ensure good hygiene for everyone.
- 2. Maintain appropriate cleaning regimes.
- 3. Keep occupied spaces well ventilated.
- 4. Follow public health advice on testing, self-isolation and managing confirmed cases of COVID-19

Please do not bring your child to school if they have Covid-19 symptoms. If anyone tests positive for Covid, we expect you to follow the Government's updated guidance:

Adults who are fully vaccinated and all children and young people aged between 5 and 18 years and 6 months <u>identified as a contact</u> of someone with COVID-19 are strongly advised to take a LFD test every day for 7 days and continue to attend their setting as normal, unless they have a positive test result.

Daily testing of close contacts applies to all contacts who are:

- fully vaccinated adults people who have had 2 doses of an approved vaccine
- all children and young people aged 5 to 18 years and 6 months, regardless of their vaccination status
- people who are not able to get vaccinated for medical reasons

Children under 5 years are exempt from self-isolation and do not need to take part in daily testing of close contacts.

Returning to England from another country

You must follow the Government's rules. What you must do depends on whether you qualify as fully vaccinated under the rules for travel to England. Please see their website for further details: Travel to England from another country during coronavirus (COVID-19) - GOV.UK (www.gov.uk)

Teachers and staff

All Azbuka staff follows an additional protocol for protective measures during coronavirus.

Visits and meetings

All meetings will take place in the school hall with a special seating arrangements. All visitors and/or participants will be asked to put on overshoes and use sanitising gel at the entrance. They are asked to wear face covering while inside the building.

! Please make sure we have an up-to-date contact phone number for you and can be reached on it during the school day.

Pre-school (NURSERY AND RECEPTION)

For detailed advice and new pick up/drop off Reception arrangements please refer to the Nursery/Reception letter, that will be sent out this week by Oksana Pavlykivska, Nursery manager.

*Children cannot attend if they, or a family member they live with, have symptoms of Covid-19

*Only one adult is to drop off/collect children.

The start/end of the day

Children to be dropped off upstairs directly into the classroom and collected upstairs at the blue door.

Start Times:

For Reception class - 8.45 am sharp (doors opening time downstairs - 8.40) For Nursery - 9.30 am (doors opening time downstairs - 9.20 till 9.45)

Finish Times:

For Reception class - 3.15 pm(doors opening time downstairs) For Nursery -1pm/2.30pm (doors opening time downstairs)

Lunchtime and snack time

Parents have to provide packed lunch and snacks (fruit or dry biscuit) packed in separate containers.

What will children need to bring/wear?

- Children need to bring their indoor shoes and spare cloths.
- Full bottle of water (children will not be able to access water fountains during the day)
- Sunhat
- Please apply sun cream before school (as required)

Arrival is from 8.45am and Pick-Up from 3:15pm.
