### COOPERATION BETWEEN SCHOOL AND PARENTS

AZBUKA has always placed great emphasis on joint work and cooperation between the school and parents:

1. We maintain a comprehensive **AZBUKA website** with detailed information on all departments and topics of discussion:

3. We hold **Open Days in English and Russian** every year, including a presentation of our underlying principles and rules as well as programmes and methods at the School and Nursery.
4. We hold an **AZBUKA Forum 2-3 times** a year for parents and the administration of the School and Nursery, where parents can discuss important issues re administration and housekeeping issues of School.
5. We cooperate with the **AZBUKA Parent Committee (PTA)**.
6. We have an Information corner for School and Nursery parents with information boards on Child Protection and general announcements/info sheets (time-tables, programme topics, messages, letters, safety measures, homework, etc.).
7. We keep a **bulletin board on health and safety and Safeguarding/Child protection**.
8. We conduct **Curriculum evenings** for parents and guardians.
9. We publish the **AZBUKA Newsletters** for Nursery and School parents (several times a year).
10. We hold **parent-teacher meetings for School and Nursery** parents 3 times a year.
11. We keep in touch by e-mail with parents on **current issues, providing information and sharing news**.
12. We encourage conversation between the parents and **“key workers” of the children** at the Nursery.

13. We **compile homework** for children.
14. We keep a **journal for each child with a separate section for Nursery parents' contributions.**
15. We make a **photo album annually** for both Nursery and School.
16. We **invite parents and grandparents to our celebrations, trips and other events.**
17. We include all Nursery parents in the database of the **AZBUKA Club** members so that they stay well informed of activities at AZBUKA (events, holidays, trips, etc.).
